Always use a start date that is one day prior to the day you want for the download. The Shopify time difference for the site requires this date entry process. If you want to the download first payout date as Nov 21, then make the starting date Nov 20.

Save the resulting Refunds files to your computer with a valid filename so you know what the file contains, something like SHOPFY_REFUNDS_2018_01-07.csv. This file will be used as an upload to the SimplePort service to accurately track Shopify refunded transactions.
